**Flight Review program for pilots around Rochester:** Most of you know I only do Flight Reviews through the FAA's WINGS Pilot Proficiency Program. I do this because WINGS is such a great program for keeping pilots current. There are three "Flight Activities" with a list of maneuvers to be flown with a CFI to complete the equivalent of a flight review. I'm offering pilots these three sorties at only \$15 per sortie and spaced about 120 days apart. These rides can be as long as you want. We can practice just about anything you want before or after you demonstrate the WINGS required maneuvers.
